WRITINGONTHEWALL off to an alert beginning, established control, was briefly guided to the rail down the backstretch before settling back into the two path, cut the pace from there facing only mild pressure, was put to hand encouragement entering the lane and drew off. REGAL WARRIOR darted over to the inside shortly after the start, raced well reserved while taking the inside route, was put to a snug hold on the reins at times during the run around the far turn, lacking opportunity to vacate the rail and forced to draft behind LINCOLN PENNY, found room to slip outward nearing the head of the stretch, was gradually angled to be four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, got turned loose and rallied to secure second. I'VE GOT THE FEVER was hustled from the starting gate to secure a forward post, was placed two wide early down the backstretch, stalked the winner from there, began to lose contact late on the far turn, then got out finished for place honors as well. LINCOLN PENNY saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. SKINNY PETER raced along the outside, was asked at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to pick up the pace. ELTHEEB strung out three wide on the opening bend, raced from between foes on the subsequent one, folded. NEVER RIGHT JOEY forwardly placed while undergoing a wide journey, gave way. SLEWS BIG FINALE three to four wide on both turns, was outrun.
