FIRST RANGER broke alertly and took command, was sent over to the rail, cut the pace with the runner up keeping watch directly to the outside, got set down for the drive home, drifting out gradually but steadily while clutching to an ever-dwindling advantage, made light contact with SANCTIFY near the wire and arrived at it in time to preserve the decision. SANCTIFY assumed the role of primary pursuer shortly after the start, kept within range down the backstretch and around the bend as well, wasn't latched on to that opponent while being allowed to drift outward, intimidating the waywardness being displayed by the eventual winner for the opening phases of the stretch run, shied outward non-deliberately in the final stages while making slight contact with the top one, missed. FOUR DIRECTIONS gave chase from the two path on the turn and rallied for the show. THRILL HILL was forced inward by CHASE THE GIANT a few jumps after the start, sat briefly along the rail before getting tipped back to the outside, appeared rank, bumping lightly with the previously-mentioned foe early down the backstretch, was still rank and unsettled amongst rivals heading for the half mile pole, managed to go about more professionally during the opening phases of the run around the bend, hand urged and between rivals, swung four wide into upper stretch, lacked a rally. EFFINEX ducked in after getting off to a stutter step start, failed to make his presence felt off the subsequent ground-saving journey. CHASE THE GIANT brushed with BRYCE BRYCE BABY at the break, was taken inward and wound up taking THRILL HILL along for a brief ride towards the rail right afterwards, jostled with the aforementioned and unruly rival a few strides later, stayed in contention until the head of the stretch and gave way. BRYCE BRYCE BABY came in slightly but enough to establish contact with CHASE THE GIANT as the field was sent off and running, raced three wide on the turn, left the five-sixteenths pole having already been put to solid encouragement, tired. KAEPERNICK underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, folded. OFFICER MAHAFFY made light contact with the left side of the starting gate, raced from off the inside, commenced the stretch four wide, trailed.
