SHEA DARBY loosely drafted behind the pacesetter while racing around the bend, got tipped outward until four to five wide during the initial portion of the stretch drive, caught the quitting leader a short distance from the sixteenth pole, kicked well clear, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. WHITE CRANE was grabbed hold after taking a couple of steps inward at the start, raced along the outside, was sent into being six wide midway through the furlong grounds, displayed a late kick to take the place. JULESCO spurred off from the others travelling two wide, got set down for the drive home, surrendered with about a sixteenth remaining and weakened into the show slot. LUMINEUSE tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, lacked the necessary stretch response. SPRITELY MAMBO got engaged in a sustained brush with ABSOLUTE PARADISE after bobbling at the start, raced near the inside to the quarter pole, made no impact. ABSOLUTE PARADISE leaned upon SPRITELY MAMBO for a few strides shortly after the start, was two wide and under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, made no headway. REBELLIOUS CHIC saved ground early, left the three-sixteenths pole four wide, failed to menace.
