AWESOME ARCENO rated off the pace, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled to be four wide coming to that station, was set down, kicked home strongly down the center of the lane collaring the leader in the last few jumps to prevail. GAME TOKEN allowed to settle early on, came under a ride near the five-sixteenths, rallied with good energy, split rivals at the eighth pole and seized command soon after, continued on well, was collared in the final jumps while safe for the place. PETE'S PARLEY settled in behind a three way pace dispute, raced three to four wide through the turn, spun four wide into the lane under a drive, rallied through the final furlong but was out kicked by the top pair while able to just preserve the show. SURPRISE STRIKE unhurried early on while settled in the two path, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, advanced steadily through the furlong ground with a mild bid to just miss show honors while clear for the last major share. TAZERED argued the pace along the inside with a duo, came under rousing at the head of the lane, dug in determined until the final eighth, steadily faded thereafter. TATAO'S WIDCAT hustled from the gate, continued to be pushed along while three wide and vying with a pair inside until the quarter pole, weakened through the lane. HAYSTACK NEEDLE broke sharply and was hustled to the front, vied between foes in the turn through a pressured pace and gave way.
