MUSTER UP put to a good hold on the reins making his way to the first turn, tracked the loose leader in the early stages, while taking the inside route, closed what was once sizeable gap, along with the others, nearing the end of the backstretch, found enough space and made a timely maneuver into the two path to avoid being shuffled back at the half mile pole, stalked within range during the run around the far turn, entered the stretch and was cut loose, emerged from the furlong grounds holding the advantage, dug in well, despite drifting outward in the last eighth to prove best. RAFFIE'S BANDIT darted over to the inside soon after breaking away from the gate, loped at the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, was taken outside and instantly picked up interest, unleashed a four wide sweep to improve position dramatically late on the second turn, unasked for speed, tipped to be widest of all at the head of the stretch and was put to a drive, rallied with good energy to garner the place. RED BENDEL sat entrenched in the two path, moved up, still well in reserve, to confront the runaway leader coming to the half mile pole, went by in unison with GOODTIME BOY upon reaching the far turn, remained a prominent pace factor until midstretch, before weakening into the show slot. GLYNISTHEMENCE off the inside in midpack, failed to fire when called upon. GOODTIME BOY three wide around both turns, tired. PLOTTER was steadied after nearly running up another's heels nearing the backstretch, was eased off the rail early down the backstretch, entered the far turn three wide, spun into the lane a bit wider and had no rally. KEVIN SILVERLASPIA made a three wide run to take the lead, opened up a good half dozen lengths between calls down the backstretch, began to shorten stride soon afterwards, got overwhelmed just past the half mile pole and stopped.
