ROCK STAR CHARLIE set the pace along the inside, was let out turning for home, responded readily staying on through the furlong grounds determinedly to prevail while kept to task. EVEN GOT QUIET unhurried initially, advanced three wide through the turn into prominence, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter while set down for the drive, steadily gained through the furlong grounds inching away at the leader throughout but couldn't go by while safely clear for the place honors. SMOKIN CANDY chased three wide throughout, came under urging just past the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide at the quarter pole displaying a mild bid to be along for the show. WHY ARGUE prompted the pace from the two path under restraint, was set down at the head of the lane, continued on well until the final eighth, began to weaken thereafter while just preserving the last major share. SNACKS off a best slow, raced unsettled early on, made progress through the turn running a bit more professionally, came under a drive at the head of the lane, offered up a mild bid while never threatening the top. OFFSHORE SCORE tracked inside under restraint until the five-sixteenths, was let out at that station, offered no response and tired. BLAKE STREET BULLY broke sharply, couldn't keep pace despite urging from the rider, offered little. TRAININGFORSUCCESS outrun early on, raced three to four wide throughout and made no impact. NORTHERN RUSH vied between rivals in midpack, came under a prolonged drive near the seven-sixteenths and offered no kick.
