SENIORS PRIDE took up the role of stalker soon after the start, contently kept a watchful eye on that rival from the outside in the initial stages, was let out a notch at the seven-sixteenths pole, left each subsequent station during the run around the far turn under stronger and stronger handling, yet lost ground on the leader, turned for home with nearly two lengths to make up, narrowed the gap from upper to midstretch, continued onward, was only a neck shy by the sixteenth pole, inched his way closer to the front thereafter and gamely got the head down on the wire to prove best. JOAN'S CHOICE established control before reaching the first turn, was rated along the inside setting the opening splits, edged away from a more energetically-handled SENIORS PRIDE on the far turn, turned for home holding his biggest advantage and was asked for run, had the winner reach his hind quarters by the furlong marker, saw the lead dwindle down to a precious neck or so with about a sixteenth remaining, dug in resolutely but came up on the short end of the win photo for all the effort. INDY SCENT saved ground and proved no match for the gallant first two finishers. SUN DANCE MOON raced along the outside and lacked the needed response. HE'S SO CHIC off the inside, was never a menace. SCREENPLAY faded off a ground-saving journey. CUSTER three wide around both turns, was through after going six furlongs.
