Footnotes

COBALTO set the pace from just off the inside, got roused nearing the quarter pole, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in under a drive, got leg weary in the late stages and just held on. HOOKED FOREVER broke out at the start, saved ground tracking just off the pace, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide in upper stretch, offered up a good kick gaining ground with every stride late and just missed. JOE MOOCH was steadied between rivals when squeezed back at the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, cut the corner into the stretch, offered up a mild bid down inside for the show honors. SUNRISE LOVER two to three wide in close pursuit urged from the three-eighths pole, spun four wide into the lane and weakened. BEAT OF THE DRUM four to five wide in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home and offered no response. ASK ABOUT ME chased three to four wide from mid pack ridden along from three furlongs out and tired. WOBURN squeezed out at the start from pressure initiated from the rail, clipped heels shortly after the break, settled three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into the stretch and never threatened.
