Footnotes

ED'S MAGIC secured a forward position after the start, cruised up in the three path on the turn towards the front runners, got set down for the drive home, took over racing through the furlong grounds and edged away. HERE COMES TOMMY appeared eager early down the backstretch, was firmly rated in the two path for the opening half, commenced the stretch three wide and rallied for the place. HALF NELSON pressed the issue from the two path, remained a prominent factor to midstretch then weakened. WESTERN TRYST stumbled at the start, was three wide entering the turn, and under a drive in the four path exiting it, lacked the needed response. BILLY THE BULL vied for command from the inside to upper stretch before giving way. JACK'S R WILD saved ground for almost a half, fanned six wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, made no impact. SNEAKY FREUD took the inside route during the opening stages, was set down and swung outward leaving the five-sixteenths marker, finished the maneuver in the five path, made no headway. PISCESBYMOONLIGHT four wide and heavily roused by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
