SOCIAL STATEMENT broke sharpest of all to take the early lead, was gradually guided over to the rail, making it in time for the run around the opening bend, set the pace along the inside, with the rider applying rating tactics, and facing pressure from the closer pursuer, was put to the test by a pair of rivals approaching the five-sixteenths pole, shook free of that duo turning for home, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage then finished with good determination to fend off the runner up in the late stages. LIFE'S MEASURE underwent a three wide journey, was put to a prolonged drive, commencing from the three-eighths pole, tipped outward a bit in upper stretch for optimal racing clearance then came home with good energy to take the place. HOT DANGER between rivals, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole and was along eventually for the show. KITTY'S THUNDER raced three wide around both turns, made a bid from there, in unison with LADY MAUREEN, placed just to her inside, kept up the pressure until upper stretch before backing off. LADY MAUREEN was rated from the two path attending pace until the five-sixteenths pole, made her move at that point, but soon flattened out. GUYANA PRINCESS was taken hold of, as the top one maneuvered over to the inside, shortly before reaching the opening bend, rode the pocket, still under a firm hold thereafter, was asked for run approaching the five-sixteenths pole, but failed to fire.
