R J'S PROSPECT strung out three wide on the first turn, proceeded from the four path around the subsequent bend, ranged up to the front runners approaching the quarter pole, rallied in earnest after being straightened away, forged to the front after a hard fought battle during the run through the furlong grounds and edged away being kept to the task at hand. GAME TOKEN made a quick move to the rail after leaving the starting gate, sat well reserved from there for nearly five furlongs, found the necessary room to angle three wide coming to the five-sixteenths pole, then displayed a good kick down the middle of the track to garner place honors. SLIGHT FEVER raced within striking distance three wide around both turns, bid successfully for the lead turning for home, gave in to the top one soon after leaving the eighth pole and steadily weakened thereafter. EVEN FRISKY saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole, and finished well belatedly for the last major share. NEXT DAY three wide around the far turn, spun six wide for the stretch drive and went on to improve position. MAGIC MAX well rated along the inside cutting the fractions, succumbed after going three-quarters. EAST END BOY coaxed along while prompting the pacesetter from the outside, folded. IDOL IMAGE spotted the competition a two length head start after leaping up just as the gate was sprung open, striking the right side of the gate in the process, was allowed to settle into stride, advanced into midpack, between rivals under his own power, remained within range, was asked for a response after turning for home, lugged in, from right handed encouragement coming to the eighth pole, shutting off SHOTGUN BANDIT as a result, and gave way. SHOTGUN BANDIT had a ground-saving journey, cut the corner, while appearing to still have some run left, checked when shut off by IDOL IMAGE a few jumps prior to the eighth pole and failed to pick up interest again thereafter.
