### Footnotes

GINGER SNAPIT worked out a tuck along the rail nearing the end of the homestretch, wresting away position from HONEY MOU and causing the rider of that mount to take hold off heels, contently tracked the front runners under a firm hold throughout most of the opening half, availed of the opportunity and was eased into the two path midway during the run around the far turn, stayed within range, angled three wide and got asked for run entering the stretch, fought her way to the front, hotly pressed by the runner up, edged away from that opponent during the final furlong, kept busy to the end. PURELY MAJESTIC raced as a forward factor three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the lane one path wider, finished willingly but had to settle for the place. HONEY MOU was forced to steady off the winner's heels as that one was being guided over to the inside, making her way to the first turn, rode the rail being rated along, found enough room to slip by the fading former pacesetter nearing the quarter pole, split rivals a sixteenth down the road, and finished with belated foot to secure the show. SASTA GO LUCKY three wide on each turn, had no kick. GET GORGEOUS patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside around the opening bend and down the backstretch, made a successful challenge for command leaving the three-eighths pole, came under pressure by the head of the stretch and succumbed. CHALK PLAYER placed four wide at the top of the lane, had no response. RED TO POSITIVE cut the corner under a drive to no avail. AURIC GIRL raced from off the rail and was through after completing three-quarters. EASY ENDING rated along the inside, wilted.
