Footnotes

PRETENSION loosely chased the front while three wide throughout, was set down nearing the quarter pole, confronted the top pair, took command in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths and edged away through the lane being kept to task. SWAG DADDY rated in midpack early on, came under coaxing near the seven-sixteenths, chased three wide through the far turn, moved into prominence and loomed at the quarter pole, rallied through the furlong grounds surging late to get up for place. SPORTSWRITER broke sharply and was rated in hand conceding the front to his more eager rival, tracked that foe from the two path throughout, came under a drive nearing the head of the lane, took over and led from the quarter pole to just near the three-sixteenths was overcome at that station, battled on through the stretch being outfinished by the top two while procuring the show. COALITION settled inside in behind the front, came under coaxing just prior to the three-eighths pole, was set down at the head of the lane from the two path, rallied mildly through the furlong grounds angling to the rail at the sixteenth pole by a tiring rival. SUMMER BREEZING bumped his inside rival lightly at the break when breaking inward, was keen early on fighting the bit while resisting the rating tactics of the rider, showed the way under stout restraint until the quarter pole, was let out at that station when overwhelmed and steadily faded through the lane. THOR'S MJOLNOR unhurried early on, was herded four wide into the first turn, tucked in one path through the turn, availed of the opportunity to slip to the rail near the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive at the head of the lane and offered no kick. MELVINDALE allowed to settle, saved ground throughout and was never a factor. BRASS NOTE reserved off the pace, raced two to three wide, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and offered little.
