DOWN BY LAW bumped with BE WITH ME at the start, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, responded positively when given her cue in upper stretch, wore down the leader in the final seventy yards to prove best. BLUEGRASS RUMOR settled along the rail shortly before completing the opening quarter, cut the pace with the top one lurking just to the outside, entered the stretch and got asked for run, held her ground well from upper to midstretch, saw the margin steadily cut into hereafter, finally yielded in the late stages, then just held on to salvage second. NEBRASKA reserved along the outside for the opening stages, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, finished well belatedly en route for the show. OPALITE took the inside route, was under urging cutting the corner into the lane, was taken outward during the initial portion of the stretch run, got outfinished. BE WITH ME made contact with the winner at the break, was rank under restraint for most of the opening quarter, slipped off the rail departing the backstretch, gave way after turning for home. SCENIC GULCH swung three wide entering the backstretch, gradually worked her way to the rail during the run around the far turn, tired.
