Footnotes

DEFLATE THE BUBBLE three wide departing the backstretch, went past FACE THE WIND and took over the two path early on the turn, began to pick up interest coming to the quarter pole, spun three wide into the stretch and commenced to rally in earnest, gained readily during the ensuing furlong, surged by the runner up in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole to gain the decision. BANGZOOMTOTHEMOON raced three wide on the turn, moved up in tandem with FIRST WHIPPOORWILL to scoot by the early pacesetter midway on the turn, turned for home and was called upon for run, shook free during the run through the furlong grounds, was powerless to stave off the winner, but continued onward to be second best. FIRST WHIPPOORWILL got away last after brushing with CHAMPAIN LADY at the start, assumed a forward position nonetheless, with the rider atop with a snug hold on the reins, rallied as a team with the runner up leaving the backstretch, easily sped past the formerly loose leader and entered the stretch still locked in battle for control, got turned back making her way to the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. BLISSFUL BELLE was never involved. CHAMPAIN LADY bumped lightly with FIRST WHIPPOORWILL at the start, was hustled along to grab the front and sped off from the competition, surrendered readily when challenged near the three-eighths pole and tired. FACE THE WIND was hustled from the gate to reach midpack, raced from off the inside, folded.
