Footnotes

STORMY'S MAJESTY away in good order, took control well before reaching the end of the homestretch, rated kindly from the rail while setting the opening splits, was let out a notch in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole and stole away to a sizeable advantage by the quarter pole, settled into upper stretch and was put to a drive, still held a healthy margin with an eighth to go, had it cut into by the runner up but held safely. INHERIT THE GOLD travelled in the three path around the first turn, remained well off the inside down the backstretch likewise, was guided into the four path at the midway point on the far turn just as the winner was kicking away, got asked for run entering the stretch, closed in with good courage during the final furlong, but had to settle for the place. STAR OF NEW YORK contently rode the rail for nearly three-quarters, slipped off the inside near the three-eighths pole, was forced to sit on hold, bidding time in traffic from the five-sixteenths pole until upper stretch, was maneuvered to be five wide, the widest off all, during the initial portion of the stretch drive, came home with good, but belatedly, energy to secure the show. UNCLE T SEVEN tracked the winner while taking the inside route, was angled outward for the stretch run, came up empty. SPA CITY FEVER three wide on both turns, folded. GROOMEDFORVICTORY kept the winner company from the two path for about six furlongs then gave way.
