KENT HALL showed good speed along the inside, angled out for the drive, responded when roused and drew clear late. SCHEMER set the pace and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. BUCK MOUNTAIN ducked out at the start, was bumped, was unhurried along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and was going well too late outside. KEESLER came in at the start, was bumped, chased the pace along the inside and offered a mild rally inside. KINGS EMPRESS was roughed up between rivals at the start, stumbled after the start, put in a three wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. PERFECT LOOK tired after a half mile. CLARKSBURG QUEEN chased the pace from the outside and tired. HURRICANE HANNAH was roughed up between rivals at the start, stumbled after the start, raced wide and tired.
