Footnotes

HITTIN THE NOTE, bumped at the start, was content to stalk the leader from the outside while keeping something in reserve until nearing the quarter pole, was put to encouragement in upper stretch, failed to make any headway, continued onward under a drive and finally wore down a weakening CASTANEDA in deep stretch to prove best. ADIRONDACK WARRIOR, was bumped at the break, sat reserved under a good hold racing along the outside, commenced his bid from the four path at the top of the lane, rallied willingly despite being erratic shying away from whip pressure throughout the stretch drive. CASTANEDA made the lead on his courage, was rated on the lead racing towards the inside until the three-sixteenths pole, responded well after being called upon, gradually increasing his edge, began shorten stride with a sixteenth to go, and relinquished the lead shortly before the wire. VLAST improved his position outkicking mainly weak ones in the stretch. UNION ARMY took the inside route, was asked for run after reaching the far turn, steadily advanced forward, but failed to sustain the bid. MOM PROOF was no factor. SWEET SIGHT raced three wide around both turns and gave way.
