IGUAZU was urged to the front while taking the inside route down the backstretch, got engaged in a spirited tussle with BANDON DUNES, from the seven-sixteenths to the three-sixteenths pole, disposed of that rival and extended out to a comfortable advantage by the eighth pole, heard hoof steps from several rivals in hot pursuit, but dug in well from that point to successfully turn back all of them. BAATESH stumbled badly at the break, wasn't rushed up, but was allowed to settle into stride under his own courage, sat reserved off the inside for nearly a half, began to pick up the pace under light encouragement, gearing up for the stretch run, angled outward, under a constant left handed stick, to the middle of the strip, then displayed a good kick to garner place honors. UPPER AFLEET unhurried during the opening half, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well. LLOYDOBLER saved ground throughout, and came home home with a mild rail rally to secure the last major slice of the pot. VAMEL chased duelists around the turn and weakened from the effort. BANDON DUNES placed in the two path, sparred with the top one from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-sixteenths pole, was shaken off at that station and eventually faded into last.
