DEPUTY DANEY broke running from the get-go, easily outspinted KRUGER PARK to take early command, spurted away to a wide-open lead by the time he reached the half mile pole, left the three-eighths pole with his biggest advantage, was put to strong handling entering the stretch and reached the wire safely for the score TEMECULA CREEK was guided over to the inside coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, unleashed a rail rally that was good enough to take the place. INDEPENDENCE WAR outrun during the early going, swung three wide into the stretch under a full drive and rallied mildly to be along in time for the show. KRUGER PARK was outspinted by the top one, despite being put to urging leaving the starting gate, chased the loose leader from afar, nibbling noticeably on the bit throughout, left the three-eighths pole from the three path, made up a bit of ground during the stretch run, but wasn't good enough to seriously threaten the winner. CALVELLO strung out three wide midpoint on the turn, was always outrun.
