Footnotes

REPTILIAN SMARTS sat reserved during the initial half, advanced rapidly into contention during the run around the second bend, while still not being asked for his best, swung out to the four path turning for home, drifted to the outside under left handed encouragement, got put back on a truer course by midstretch, then blew past the leader during the final furlong, with a loose shadow roll dangling in the vicinity of the steed's right eye. STUNGBYTHESTORM bobbed at the start, yielded command midway on the first turn, was taken out to the two path a few jumps later to assume the role of stalker, kept a watchful eye on the leader until the half mile pole, ranged up to issue his challenge for the lead nearing the top of the lane, forged to a slim advantage just past eighth pole, was quickly overwhelmed by the top one but continued on willingly to protect the place slot. HURRICANE HEAT chased the front runners three wide until midpoint on the far turn before seeking refuge on the rail, made up a good amount of ground, maintained that momentum after cutting the corner, was partially through a hole inside of MARINA MARKET midstretch, when the rider checked, got back on stride soon afterwards and altered course to the outside, then displayed a late kick to grab the show. O'KID was no factor. MARINA MARKET took over on the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, came under assault approaching the quarter pole, offered resistance until the eighth pole before steadily weakening thereafter. FERENTZ trailed throughout.
