Footnotes

PURRRFECT BLUFF settled in good position behind the early speed duel, angled out while making a quick three wide move to take charge at the quarter pole and drew off in hand with the rider glancing back in midstretch. REFORESTATION raced between horses along the backstretch, advanced three wide on the turn and finished willingly to clearly best the others. DISTINCT TREND trailed after breaking slowly, raced in traffic behind horses on the turn and improved his position through the stretch. UPHILL WILDCAT dueled on the rail for a half and tired. PLEASANT SISTER a bit slow to gain stride, raced in traffic between horses for a half, angled four wide and lacked a rally. PEA STONE saved ground after breaking slowly and failed to threaten. DANCING WITH LIONS pressed in the two path, steadied in upper stretch and gave way. CAT GRACE gave way after racing four wide for a half.
