SMOKIN HERO sped towards the front after leaving the starting gate, despite bobbling at the break, was taken back soon afterwards, moved out to the two path, stalked the leader while attempting to resist the rating tactics being applied by the rider, was asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole, couldn't make up ground on the confidently-ridden winner, but held on willingly to procure the place. MOR CHANCES raced three wide, was put to encouragement on the turn, but failed to gain any ground. SEE MORE SPIRIT outrun for a half, outfinished weak ones in the lane. MR. WINDJAMMER saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole and tired. CITIFEST kept off the inside, was no threat.
