Footnotes

NAVEDANO trailed the field during the initial half, commenced her rally after turning for home, sped past rivals with a strong kick, was carried out by and brushed with HOOKED ON MONEY, but continued on with determination nonetheless to prove best. HOOKED ON MONEY squeezed back at the start, took the inside route, angled outward in the vicinity of three-sixteenths pole, closed in on the front runners, drifted out in the late stages, despite receiving strong right handed encouragement, brushing with the top one in the process, dug in gamely, but came up short. GRACIOUS VICTORY near the front soon after the start, was eased back to avoid hooking up in duel with her entry mate, was content to track the front runners from the pocket until nearing the quarter pole, commenced her rally at that point, gained a slim edge in deep stretch only to get caught by the top pair near the finish line. SUPER CHILD forwardly placed, fought for the lead during the final furlong, weakened in the final yards. SUMWHROVRATHERAINBW lacked the needed stretch response in the late stages. WINDY CORNER ducked out sharply at the break, bothering a pair of rivals in the process, went on to prompt the pace from the outside, forged to a head advantage leaving the eighth pole, yielded in short order and weakened steadily thereafter. APPLE saved ground, moved into striking position with a rail rally after turning for home, was steadied behind rivals at the eighth pole, while appearing to have sufficient clearance to continue his advance, altered course shortly afterwards, but failed to get back into stride. HOT AND BOTHERED cut the fractions towards the inside until midstretch and gave way. ED'S PRINCESS tired after a half. KIARA (COL) squeezed back at the start, was no factor. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner up against the rider of the winner alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
