JOHANNESBURG SMILE was lightly urged to establish command, set the pace towards the inside on a loosely-contested lead, was set down turning for home, held on for the decision, despite drifting outward during the stretch drive. SHRIMP DANCER unhurried for a half, raced four wide around the second turn, commenced his rally approaching the quarter pole, bumped with SMOOTH TRANSITION moments after the incident in upper stretch, then continued on with good courage, but was unable to reel in the top one. SMOOTH TRANSITION tracked the pacesetter while racing along the inside, abandoned the pocket as the field approached the top of the stretch, bumped with SHRIMP DANCER in upper stretch, lacked the needed bid after being called upon. FORTUNATE RUN underwent a three wide journey and tired. CRESCENT'S MON had no rally. THUNDER CHIEF within striking distance, was checked to avoid the stricken foe, losing any opportunity thereafter. SHOTGUN BANDIT outrun, drifted to the far outside at the quarter pole and was eased to the wire. THOUSAND EXCUSES made a good rail advance into contention while keeping something in reserve, appeared poised to make a meaningful run at the leader when he broke down at the top of the stretch. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the incident in the stretch before the result was declared official.
