BOMBER BOY was kept to some coaxing tracking the the leader from the pocket, got put to much stronger handling by the five-sixteenths pole after losing some ground, found enough room to be maneuvered into the two path for the stretch drive and was fully turned loose, fought his way past a stubborn FRENCH FURY to take over at the sixteenth pole, then kicked away, crossing the finish line under hand encouragement. PERCUSSION sat reserved from off the inside for the opening half, was taken over to a clear passageway along the rail in upper stretch, gained ground readily during the ruin through the furlong grounds, altered course back to the outside in midstretch, lost valuable momentum, having now been positioned behind foes initially, requiring the rider to ease yet again towards the middle of the strip, finished well thereafter to garner the place. FRENCH FURY showed the way from the inside, was put to a hard drive entering the stretch, offered good resistance until the sixteenth marker, yielded at that station and backed away. SUPERESTRELLA put to a prolonged drive, was outrun. QUICK TO STRIKE stumbled badly at the break, moved up into the role of stalker without missing a beat, raced in attendance with the pacesetter from the outside for almost a half and gave way. IT'S HUGE departed the backstretch from the three path, folded.
