Footnotes

COOSADA crossed to the three path soon after the start, was allowed to settle early on, raced three wide in the turn, was set down at the quarter pole, steadily gained through the initial portion of the stretch, displayed a late surge through the final sixteenth coming with a rush to just get up and prevail at the wire. MINESWEPT tracked the pace from the two path, maneuvered to the rail near the five sixteenths, was roused at the quarter and rallied readily up the rail displacing the leader poking a head in front just outside the final sixteenth, was caught in the final stride and had to settle for place honors. HEWITTS hustled to the front from the get go, set the pace inside under light coaxing, was further asked at the head of the lane and responded digging in and holding well through the lane until the final sixteenth when succumbing the lead and being outfinished strides from the wire. CROWN THE CHIEF under a firm hold, was rated just off the pace up close and prominent while three wide, was let out near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, rallied but was out kicked through the latter stages of the stretch drive and had to settle for the last major share. SAINT DAIMON reserved off the pace, came under coaxing near the seven-sixteenths, was in tight for a few strides in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, bumped with W.W.'S LADY'S MAN, causing that rival to steady, continued under coaxing being put to some stick work into the lane and made no late headway. GLACIER BAY raced between rivals on the turn, came under a drive at the head of the lane and offered no response. DEVONSHIRE outrun early on, offered little. AMERICAN CLASSIC chased the pace four wide in the turn, offered no late bid when called upon. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN tracked the pace inside, was in tight and forced to steady when bumped by SAINT DAIMON near the three-eighths, steadily faded thereafter and was not persevered with.
