Footnotes

CHRISTOPHER'S JOY shied outward at the start as CHECK THE CITIES was heading in his direction, kicked clear of tightly-bunched grouping in the initial stages to grab the advantage, gradually worked his way over to the inside and made it there by the end of the backstretch, cut the pace, facing no real resistance, slightly off the rail and being rated along, felt the closest pursuers increasing the pressure heading for the top of the lane and got let out in response, lost no ground during the ensuing furlong, with the runner up hemmed in on the inside route with some but not sufficient clearance to launch a rally of his own, saw the lead dwindle down steadily in the last eighth, but was kept going well enough long enough to preserve it. FLO'S GREATNESS kept a watchful eye on the winner while sitting loosely-pocketed, picked up the pace coming to the quarter pole, entered the stretch, caught in some traffic behind the top one while travelling alongside TALENTED WHIZ, raced through the furlong grounds, with tempting but less than optimal clearance down the rail on one hand and with virtually the same situation to his outside between the front runners, committed to making a move towards the latter as TALENTED WHIZ was drifting inward slightly and bumped with that rival, remained locked in behind the top one, bulled his way towards freedom in the final seventy yards and flashed some late foot en route for the place. TALENTED WHIZ put to some coaxing, prompted the leader from the outside, entered the stretch and was asked for more, drifted in slightly after one solitary right handed shot just as the second place finisher was coming outward himself, made contact with that foe, continued onward and began to close the gap, lost position getting carried outward a bit by the runner up in deep stretch, resulting in missing out on the place. GALAXY KAT rode the rail for nearly a half, angled three wide into the stretch and gained ground gradually. SUNSHINE VALENTINO chased outside and lacked the necessary response. JEMARU entered the turn three wide, was in the six path exiting it, tired. HURRICANE HEAT four wide at the three-eighths pole, was no factor. CHASIN THE CASH swung five wide into the stretch, had no rally. SECURITY GUARD saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun. CHECK THE CITES broke outward, raced three wide on the turn, tired. DAUNTING (IRE) chased outside and tired. EZZY fanned five wide into the stretch, gave way.
