Footnotes

WILD FINISH gained a slim advantage soon after the start, was kept to a good hold by the pilot vying to maintain it, had BROTHER BOB issue a challenge in earnest in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, with the runner up adding to the pressure about a sixteenth later, entered the stretch having already been asked for run for a couple of jumps, dug in with good determination to fend off LEILANI'S TICKET to prove best. LEILANI'S TICKET got bumped shortly after leaving the starting gate, the last of three to have been affected by pressure originated by a wayward BROTHER BOB as the field was sent off and running, was primarily three wide while giving chase on the turn, closed the gap approaching the quarter pole and issued a bid, remained latched on to that opponent throughout the stretch run but got outfinished. CHAPMAN carried outward at the start, steadied after being bumped from between rivals, took up position briefly along the inside, vacated the premises by the three-eighths pole, remained reserved until entering the stretch, fanned outward during the run through the furlong grounds, was five wide by the eighth pole, rallied willingly to grab the show award. BROTHER BOB broke outward, bumping with the nearest rival and carrying that one far enough to cause additional bumps shortly afterwards involving another pair as well, was rated along the outside as the primary pursuer until halfway on the turn, got let out a notch and arrived at the five-sixteenths marker on nearly even terms, had the second place finisher arrive on the scene as the three front runners were spinning into the stretch, fought from between foes for the lead from upper to midstretch then backed away. RAMBLING was bumped by BROTHER BOB and carried outward at the start, had the rider steady after making contact with CHAPMAN a couple of strides later, raced along the outside, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, failed to menace. RUN RUN FORREST tracked the winner from the pocket, doing so under a firm to snug hold down the backstretch, faltered.
