AUSTIN'S MOM was rated along inside, advanced inside on the second turn, found room on the rail in upper stretch, stormed on through, spurted clear after one right handed slap from the whip and was ridden out to the wire. U K TRICK hit the rail on the first turn, was rated inside, advanced on the second turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely despite drifting out in the stretch. BIOGIO'S BEAUTY raced with the pace while three wide on both turns and weakened in the final furlong. CONSORT MUSIC was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. GOLDEN DAMSEL quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and gave way in the stretch. GREEN JEANS chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. DANCEN IN THE SUN chased the pace while between rivals and tired after three quarters.
