Footnotes

NAVEDANO was outrun in the two path for three furlongs, gained on the turn, swung four wide entering the stretch and closed steadily from outside to get up in the final jump. GRIFFEN AVENUE sprinted well clear in the opening quarter, opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and was nipped at the wire while weakening late. GATTO NERO checked after breaking slowly, steadied sharply between horses at the five-eighths pole, rushed up from outside, closed the gap three wide on the turn then flattened out. SEE ME angled in during the early stages, raced up close early, saved ground while dropping back on the turn and failed to threaten thereafter. REFINERY FIRE drifted out on the backstretch, raced wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. WESTERN BUFF showed only brief speed on the rail. DEVILISHAMEYE chased the leader four wide to the turn and gave way. SPLIT POT refused to break. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
