Footnotes

WEST COAST FLIER pressed the pace from outside along the backstretch, lodged an outside bid nearing the quarter pole, took charge in upper stretch and drew off while drifting out a bit in the late stages. BAND OF THUNDER set the pace under pressure along the rail into upper stretch and held well to narrowly gain the place. TEMECULA CREEK steadied sharply after breaking outward at the start, raced far back to the turn, closed the gap to reach contact with the field nearing the quarter pole, swerved five wide in upper stretch and finished strongly in the middle of the track to narrowly miss the place. CAYMAN CONDO was well placed along the rail for a half, angled out and lacked a late response. KAPER LAKE raced within striking distance three wide to the turn and lacked a further response. FUJITA broke a bit slowly and was outrun along the rail. FOREST ATTACK moved between horses on the backstretch, steadied while lacking room at the three-eighths pole, dropped back in upper stretch and checked slightly while tiring in midstretch.
