Footnotes

HOOPSKIRT put to early restraint by the pilot, fought noticeably on the bit making his way towards the end of the homestretch, proved ratable upon entering the first turn, stalked the front runners down the backstretch, picked up interest and made a successful three wide move past MISS MEXIQUE to take over as the primary pursuer in the vicinity of the half mile pole, continued to advance and soon took over the front as well, drew out to a commanding lead from the quarter pole to midstretch, then held sway. TWILLERBEE had a ground-saving journey and rallied to grab the place. SCENIC GULCH took an awkward first step inward making light contact with the starting gate as a result, approached the opening bend four wide but worked out a tuck one path closer to the rail shortly afterwards, stayed at a considerable distance from off the inside thereafter, was about three wide for the start of the stretch run and mustered up a mild response to take the show. G. A. EMPRESS rode the rail for nearly three-quarters, angled three wide into the stretch and finished well enough to grab the last major check. WISE CHOICE three wide on both turns, folded. MISS MEXIQUE made a three wide run to secure a narrow advantage, surrendered it to STELLARS THEORY midway down the backstretch, was taken hold of momentarily, getting displaced in second by the eventual winner after going a half, got asked for more, failed to response and backed away. STELLARS THEORY vied inside for the lead for six furlongs and gave way. BEAUTIFUL RISK swung four wide into the backstretch, remained just as wide on the far turn, failed to reach a contending position.
