TOQUE broke well and grabbed the early advantage, was sent over to the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, showed the way, with HEWITTS applying good pressure parked one path to the outside, turned for home still holding a slim advantage and got called upon shortly afterwards, kicked clear of his former nemesis in the ensuing furlong, maintained a healthy lead to the end under good handling. SENSATIONAL SLAM sat well reserved and well placed off the duelers during the run around the bend, was kept on hold awaiting suitable options nearing the quarter pole, failed to respond appreciably to the pilot's attempt to alter course in upper stretch, did so on the second try, but not before having lost some ground and momentum, settled into his best stride for the final furlong and went onto secure second. GAME TOKEN was swung over to the rail coming to the top of the turn, cut the corner into the lane, finished willingly en route for the show. HEWITTS disputed the pace from the outside, was called upon nearly simultaneously when the winner was, dropped back quickly nevertheless. ULTIMO PRINCIPE raced three wide on the turn, gave way. RICH HERO was hustled into midpack, saved ground until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. KID WANDO three wide midway on the turn, was outrun.
