JOAN'S CHOICE quickly established control, was guided over to the inside before reaching the end of the homestretch, set moderate splits, well rated and only loosely-pressed by the runner up, positioned one path to his outside, staved off that one's attempt to increase his presence during the run on the far turn, holding something in reserve all the way to the quarter pole, turned for home and got set down to a brisk hand ride, kicked well clear, kept busy to the end. ISN'T HE PERFECT was grabbed hold after breaking slightly inward, assumed a forward position and patiently stalked the winner from the outside, being rated along, got let out a notch leaving the half mile pole attempting to latch on to the top one, failed to do so, despite having been put to considerate encouragement, continued onward to be second best. EA three wide around both turns, was asked for run by the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top twosome. KEEP ME INFORMED raced from off the inside, middle-moved down the backstretch to improve position, was put to a full drive after going halfway on the far turn, made no headway on the frontrunners. BURNED BRIDGES swung four wide into the stretch, had no response.
