IRON LOU tracked the pace along the inside under urging from the three-eighths pole, shifted to the three path straightening for home, dug in under a drive steadily rallying to get up in the final strides. KID BLAST vied from the two path with LUDO BAGMAN to his outside, came under urging cutting the corner into the stretch, fought on regaining a narrow advantage a furlong out, dug in determined repulsing his main foe to the line but was caught in the final jumps by the aforementioned rival. LUDO BAGMAN came in at the start squeezing CHARLIE'S PUNCH and SMOKIN HERO continued cross reined and hustled to vie from the three path for command, got asked nearing the quarter pole with a narrow advantage, battled on through the stretch with good energy but was outfinished in the late stages. THOR'S MJOLNOR just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, offered up mild late energy to procure the last major share. REGGIE D saved ground throughout settled towards the rear early on, was placed to encouragement three furlongs out, offered up a mild bid in deep stretch but was out kicked to the wire. COALITION lunged at the start conceding three to four lengths to the front, settled three wide towards the rear, came under a ride midway on the turn, angled four wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild bid through the lane while unable to make an impact. CHARLIE'S PUNCH squeezed between rivals at the start from pressure by LUDO BAGMAN coming in, chased four wide in close pursuit under urging from the five-sixteenths and weakened. SMOKIN HERO squeezed between rivals at the start, took the overland route throughout, came under the whip midway on the turn and tired. LUXURY APPEAL just off the pace chasing from just off the inside, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole, retreated, stopped then was not persevered with in the stretch.
