EDDIE'S POINT outrun for a half while racing off the inside, was set down turning for home, gained readily on the fading pacesetter, thought about angling inward for an instance, but altered course to the outside nearing the sixteenth pole, then closing with good energy, proved best in the late stages. CLASSROOM LEGEND sluggish early, moved into midpack with a three wide bid around the turn, was one of a host of rivals making up a sizeable amount of real estate on the pacesetter, continued on with good courage during final furlong to earn place honors. OUT BID hustled throughout the running of the contest, forged his way to a slim lead leaving the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly before relinquishing shortly before the finish line. S. Z. MADISON outrun during the initial half, finished willingly down the outside of the strip. MIND BOGGLING lacked the necessary stretch response after being called upon. SLIGHT FEVER was no factor. BRUSHED OFF saved ground and failed to menace. RAGING MEESE spurred away to a long lead after entering the turn, began to shorten stride noticeably by the three-sixteenths pole and was soon overwhelmed. DIXIELORE was no threat. MAXIMUS PROSPECTOR tired after a half.
