GOOD WILL away in good order, quickly established command, showed the way along the inside on a loosely-contested lead, edged away from the field after turning for home, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage then needed to dig in stubbornly to preserve the decision. CARLYN DARLYN reserved off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to garner place honors. BOBS PINUP GIRL checked along the inside when caught in traffic nearing the opening bend, took the inside route while racing near the back of the pack, was taken out to the two path after entering the backstretch, remained on hold without significantly improving her position, was forced to steady nearing the far turn to avoid running up on a rival, waited behind foes until the quarter pole, angled outward a bit before asked for a response, advanced towards the front runner, split rivals at the eighth pole and continued on willingly to grab the show. SUN SHOWER prompted the leader from the two path and held on reasonably well during the stretch drive. BARONESS bumped lightly with EIGHTYFIVE S. soon after the start, attempted to enter the fracas with a four wide run around the second turn, but failed to sustain the bid after turning for home. EIGHTYFIVE S stumbled badly at the start, recovered from that ordeal only to be forced to steady when caught in tight quarters between rivals nearing the opening turn, then was forwardly placed for six furlongs before giving way. WHY SO EASY steadied after the start, was always outrun. KEY TRIP was through after completing three-quarters. ELENA'S PRINCESS stopped after a half.
