CONGO away in good order, took up position in the two path, sat reserved from there, well within striking distance, during the opening three-quarters, paused briefly awaiting options heading for the stretch, was put to encouragement advancing towards a widening hole developing between rivals just up ahead, split that pair en route to taking over command at the eighth pole, then edged away under a vigorous hand ride to the end. SOUTH FLEET contently prompted the pacesetter, under a good hold, and perched just off that one's hind quarters, moved up to issue a challenge for command coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, led briefly on the far turn, continued the fight with HARDSHELL after entering the stretch, finally put the aforementioned opponent away for good with about an eighth to go, wasn't up to the task of keeping pace with the top one, but finished with good determination to earn place honors. CALL THE BALL three wide around both turns, weakened during the final furlong. DIVINE CHILD between rivals for much of the running, was put to a prolonged drive, flashed some late foot while nailing down the last major share. HARDSHELL off to an alert start, nibbled on the bit before settling down kindly midway on the first turn, was rated on the lead while taking the inside route, briefly surrendered it to the runner up soon after departing the backstretch, re bid successfully at the three-eighths pole, continued to vie for command before backing off at the eighth pole. BLACK MARKET MONEY bumped lightly with ISN'T HE PERFECT at the break, went three wide around the opening bend and was outrun. ISN'T HE PERFECT lightly bumped at the start, saved ground and through after completing three-quarters.
