MAJESTIC HOPE stalked the front runners three wide around the bend, was put to some encouragement at the three-eighths pole, bid in earnest under much strong handling turning for home, grabbed command shortly before reaching the furlong marker and edged away under a strong drive to the end. WING GLIDER broke quickly and assumed the lead, was rated on a loosely-contested lead from the inside during the initial half, was set down after entering the stretch, gave in to the top one's pressure during the latter stages of the run through the furlong grounds, but continued on willingly to secure the place. MARKET ANALYSIS was coaxed while chasing the leader, bid mildly from the three-eighths pole to the quarter pole, was still in the thick of things, when he lugged in sharply, appearing in response to right handed whipping, approaching the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. READ THE E MAIL raced along the outside and was no factor. LITTLE BLOW HEART was urged from the get-go, took the inside route and was through after completing a half. SE DIO VUOLE broke in the air, and trailed throughout.
