Footnotes

POWER KING chased the pace from the two path, confronted the leader in earnest nearing the quarter pole, was asked for more at that station, took command turning for home by the slimmest of margins, saw his stubborn rival reestablish the lead just after the eighth pole, dug in to go in front for good at the sixteenth marker and prevailed. SASTRE reserved off the pace, saved ground through the turn, came under a ride near the five-sixteenths, kicked on belatedly to just get up for the place in the last jumps. CALL THE BALL set the pace from the two path, was confronted at the head of the lane and was displaced from the lead, fought on when roused at that station digging in to regain the front just past the eighth pole, was headed yet again at the sixteenth pole, began to weaken while well clear for show honors. TROPONIN hustled from the gate, came under a prolonged hard drive from the seven-sixteenths, raced four wide through the turn and tired. THE CUFF SHOOTER under coaxing at the rear, saved ground throughout and was no factor. WADI SUKI tracked the pace inside while prominent until the seven-sixteenths and steadily retreated thereafter. DONTSTEALMYLAND trailed throughout.
