RAFFIE'S CHOICE underwent a three wide journey, ranged up to issue a challenge coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took charge soon afterwards, drew out to a comfortable advantage by the furlong marker and continued to lengthen away from the competition, kept to steady hand urging to the end. EL DREAMER raced from off the inside in midpack for nearly three-quarters, was let out a notch and loosely drafted behind OMMADON'S REIGN taking the three path into the stretch, chose to change course towards the rail approaching the eighth pole, herded SANDICAN inward along the way to the rail, causing that rival as well two others to be steadied, continued onward to garner the place. OMMADON'S REIGN saved ground in the opening stages, was eased off the inside midway on the far turn, settled to be three wide for the stretch run and entered the lane already under urging, displayed a mild response to get up for the show. EMBUR'S MADURO stalked the pacesetter from the outside, rated along until late on the second turn, made a run for the front as the field headed for the stretch, flattened out departing the furlong grounds. SANDICAN came out slightly leaving the gate, initiating light contact with ALL ZIPPED UP as a result, sat reserved along the outside for almost six furlongs, picked up the pace heading for the quarter pole, appeared to be moving willingly when carried inward by an errant rival coming to the eighth pole, got put in tight quarters and was forced to be steadied, losing both ground and momentum, got going once more and flashed some belated interest. POKE SLAM raced three wide until the seven-sixteenths pole, was caught up in the chain reaction of trouble in midstretch resulting in the rider putting a good hold on the reins. CAMERON CANYON sped towards the front and tucked along the rail soon after entering the opening bend, was rated while setting the opening splits, came under pressure leaving the three-eighths pole, and got let out in response, appeared to be backing away, when steadied in tight at the eighth pole, from outside pressure. ALL ZIPPED UP faded off a ground-saving journey.
