MR PALMER bumped lightly at the start by NAVY GUARD breaking inwards, settled three wide in pursuit, ranged up under mostly his own power to take command nearing the half mile pole, inched away through the turn under patient handling, got let cutting the corner into the stretch, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in under a drive to hold on repulsing a late threat at the wire. INCOGNITO tracked inside from towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out, cut the corner into the stretch into contention, kicked home with late energy mostly displayed through the final sixteenth and just missed. NAVY GUARD broke in at the start brushing the near side stall then bumped MR PALMER lightly soon after, settled three wide towards the rear, shifted out a path at the three-eighths pole commencing a drive, swung four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. INMYFATHERSIMAGE just off the pace in pursuit while two to three wide, got called upon midway on the turn, remained prominent to the five sixteenths and steadily weakened. REGULAR BUSINESS four wide in mid pack down the backside, came under the whip three wide three furlongs out, offered no serious response before weakening in the stretch. CHAMBERS BAY away well, crossed to the two path into the turn on the pace, got displaced on the front nearing the half mile pole, retreated to the rear while stopping, then was eased in the stretch.
