ELGHAYOOR brushed lightly by TRUE FORTUNE a couple of jumps after the start, sat patiently perched three wide off the embattled pair just up ahead, was cued up with some hand encouragement in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker and ranged up to increase her presence as the field headed for the stretch, went by KISS THE LADY a short distance from the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly under good handling to fend off the runner up. RAILTOWN GIRL off the inside, had the rider atop with a firm grip on the reins for a half, fanned three to four wide into the stretch, finished willingly en route for the place. KISS THE LADY raced along the outside, sparred for command with CUBICLE QUEEN for most of the opening half, put that opponent away but gained no respite, got pounced upon by the eventual winner, offered good resistance until deep into the furlong grounds, relinquished at that juncture and steadily backed away. TRUE FORTUNE drifted slightly to the outside after bobbling at the break, making light contact with the top one, saved ground down the backstretch and around the bend, was four wide spinning into the lane, failed to muster up a closing response. MAGGIESFREUDDNSLIP broke outward, raced four wide on the turn and into the stretch, folded. CUBICLE QUEEN dueled with KISS THE LADY while taking the inside route, got shaken off prior to completing a half, became choppy-gaited at the three-sixteenths pole, dropped back readily thereafter and was pulled up quickly after crossing the finish line.
