BELLE GALLANTEY rated kindly while prompting the runner up from the two path, drew off from others in tandem with that opponent during the run around the second bend, with the pilot of each mount keeping something in reserve for more than six furlongs, got set down after settling into upper stretch, took over shortly afterwards and kicked away, crossing the wire being briskly hand urged. NATALIE VICTORIA broke alertly and assumed command, was sent over to the rail, cut the pace with the eventual winner keeping watch parked one path farther to the outside, scampered off from the rest of the competition along with the top one after the half had been completed, spun into the lane side by side with BELLE GALLANTEY and got called upon at the same time as the nemesis did, yielded in short order, had no trouble though completing the run down the lane to be second best. VERY CHERRY CANDY was bumped from both sides at the start, sat loosely pocketed for the majority of the initial half, tipped into the two path and took it around the far turn, proved no match. GO OLIVIA GO got away last after taking an awkward first step, saved ground for three-quarters and went on to best the rest. MY HONEY LAURIE broke two to three beats slowly after brushing the side of the starting gate, went by weak and tired ones. COAST OF SANGRIA in slightly, was bumped at the break, gave chase from the two path without making her presence felt, commenced the stretch three wide to no avail. TWILLERBEE veered out sharply, was grabbed hold of but made solid contact with the next door neighbor anyway, was three wide on the opening bend, continued from off the inside and gave way.
