PEOPLE'S PRINCESS was unhurried early on, rallied three wide on the second turn, dug in gamely outside in the stretch and drew clear under a drive. ZONK was rated inside, rallied on the rail on the second turn, came out entering the stretch, angled in in upper stretch and finished gamely on the rail. POCUS HOCUS quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and weakened while between rivals in the drive, her rider having lost his whip in midstretch. A. O. L. HAYES raced close up while in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, was taken up from between rivals turning for home and tired. RIFT VALLEY was being handled and was unprepared when the gates opened, was away well behind the field and raced inside. KRIS PIT dropped back early and had no response when roused. POIVRE (CHI) stumbled at the start, raced inside and had no response when roused. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul against the top two finishers by the trainer of the fourth place finisher, ZONK was disqualified from second position and placed fourth for interference entering the stretch.
