WINE BAR pressed the pace from outside, inched closer leaving the eighth pole and prevailed in deep stretch. FAIR LADY OLIVIA rushed up to gain the early advantage, maintained a clear lead in midstretch, dug in leaving the sixteenth pole and yielded grudgingly. GRACE AND COURAGE saved ground in hand to the turn, angled out entering the stretch and gained gradually for a share. BUDDY SYSTEM was unhurried early, gained outside on the turn and rallied mildly. SWEETHEARTS KISS was outrun after breaking slowly. ROARING ALY chased between horses into upper stretch and tired. VERBETICA swung wide on the turn and failed to mount a serious rally. SMOKEY EYES stumbled at the start, angled in on the far turn, saved ground while gaining on the turn and was pulled up late and vanned off.
