LINEAR MOTION ducked out at the start, was grabbed hold and put back on course, was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, steadily advanced into contention, chose to continue to hug the rail after the runner up vacated the premises leaving the three-eighths pole, entered the stretch with the front runners well within range, altered course out several paths at the three-sixteenths pole for optimal racing clearance, kicked in when asked, closed in readily despite drifting outward, then snatched away the lead in the final seventy yards, with the rider flashing the whip from the right side. CAPTAIN FERTOLI rode the rail during the initial stages, availed of the opportunity to slip off the inside leaving the three-eighths pole, swung three wide for the stretch drive, perched just to the outside of the pair of duelists, responded well when set down, battled hard for command, proved no match for the top one when that opponent arrived on the scene, but continued on with good determination to wrest away place honors from GOODNIGHT BRAD late. GOODNIGHT BRAD deliberately kept slightly off the inside, got hooked up in a protracted duel with WILDCAT STEVIE almost from the get-go, went head to head with that rival from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-sixteenths pole, briefly shook free before being pressured once again, this time by the runner up, held his ground as well as possible but had to settle for show honors. JITALIAN three wide at the half mile, never reached contention. WILDCAT STEVIE urged from the starting gate, sparred with GOODNIGHT BRAD while travelling in the two path, backed off after reaching the three-sixteenths pole. BRIGADIER GENERAL was taken in hand after bobbling at the start, raced along the outside and was through after completing a half.
