EMINENT TALE quickly established command, cut the pace from the inside, placed under a snug hold, continued along on the same scenario until the three-eighths pole, was given some rein, in preparation for the stretch drive, drew out to a comfortable advantage once asked for a response in upper stretch, then dug in well to successfully stave off the runner up. SKY MUSIC off a beat slowly, settled in the back of the pack during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, was maneuvered well to the outside, leaving the first turn, sat reserved from there under a firm hold, bided time until departing the backstretch, accelerated towards the front runners when put to some mild hand urging, coming to the three-eighths pole, picked up speed, splitting rivals a sixteenth down the road, continued his advance, spun four wide into the stretch, lost none of the momentum after settling into upper lane, then closed in strongly on the top one leaving the eighth pole to be clearly second best. UNCLE SMOKEY underwent a three to four wide journey and rallied mildly to be along for the show. GOLD RAPTOR loosely prompted the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs and folded. RAM bumped lightly with BEAU DE BEAUPRE at the start, acted rankly, stubbornly resisting the ratings tactics being applied by the rider during the run around the opening bend, settled down in a more professional manner upon reaching the backstretch, took the inside route, angled out at the eighth pole but failed to muster up a solid closing punch. BEAU DE BEAUPRE lightly bumped at the start, raced three wide around both turns and had nothing left to give after turning for home.
