Footnotes

BACK TO HURSTLAND patiently tracked the front runners, while positioned slightly off the inside, was taken into the two path a few strides prior to the quarter pole, was put encouragement, lumbered towards the leader, struck the front at the eighth pole and edged away, driving. LOVE FEVER inherited the front, once CHERISHED GENNA bolted down the backstretch, cut the pace from the inside, was put to the test in upper stretch, yielded at the eighth pole but continued onward to be second best. LEGIONS STAR swung four wide into upper stretch and bested the rest. HIS PRECIOUS LADY pressed the pacesetter from the outside until midpoint on the far turn and gave way. ONE SPRING STORM raced three wide around both turns, had the rider lose the left iron in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, attempted to lug inward several times, requiring strong pressure from the rider on the right rein each time to counteract it, failed to fire appreciably after entering the stretch, with the rider eventually coming of the right iron, as well, at the eight pole. GLANCE MY WAY was the last to pop out, after smacking the right side of the starting gate, raced along the outside and was never involved. CHERISHED GENNA broke running, was on the lead when he bolted to the extreme outside, was never asked for run thereafter and finally eased turning for home.
